## President's Report - None

**Secretary's Report** – The minutes for the regular March 6, 2023 board meeting were reviewed and approved on a motion made by Bev Potts, seconded by Annette Brehmer, all in favor.

<u>Correspondence</u> – The Solar energy paperwork has been completed and the subscription has started. Information on the tax levies for Tazewell and Woodford Counties has been received. The library has received donations from G.A. Rich, Goodfield State Bank and Aunt Em's. The Morton Community Foundation/Karl and Mary Eschelbach Deer Creek Library District Fund has been established with annual distributions for our library.

<u>New Business</u> – Budget Outlook FY 2023/2024 - Meghan provided board members with a preview of the budget. Paid Leave Act (SB0208) – Meghan went over how this will affect our library as we provide paid time off for our part-time employees. Decennial Committee Act (50 ILCS70/1) – We need to form a committee that includes all library board members and 2 community members who will meet three times, the first in May 2023. Protecting Freedom to Read Act (HB2789) – not official yet, but a new law from the Secretary of State about anti-book banning.
